### 39<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL OHIO K of C STATE FAMILY CAMPOUT - -

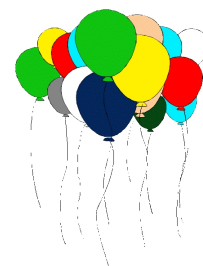
